



Maintenance

Maintenance

The time remaining until routine maintenance is next due depends on the way the engine's lubricant ages. Your vehicle's electronics keep a constant record of driving and engine data and use this information to calculate how many kilometres remain before maintenance work is next required.

>Note!

Lubricants continue to age even if your car is driven rarely or not at all. In this instance, the maintenance interval display will be expressed in days.

The routines

- service scope A car care
- service scope B service inspection are performed alternately.

>Note!

All service inspections and service scopes are subject to possible modifications from the manufacturer.

Original parts

Any repairs that are required are carried out at an authorised workshop, e.g. at your smart center, using original smart parts. To ensure that your vehicle remains a source of enjoyment for as long as possible, we recommend that you use original smart parts.
